




Installing the Locrating Property Portal Chrome extension


- Open the Chrome extension page in Chrome using the following URL:



- Click the add to Chrome button:




- Agree to the message that says the extension can modify the Zoopla, Rightmove and OnTheMarket websites, by clicking "Add extension":



- Once installed when you visit any of these portals and view a property's details page, Locrating will appear at the top showing the property on the Locrating map, as below:





Accessing members data


- You can access members-only data in the map, by signing into Locrating in the normal way, e.g. clicking the login icon in the top right corner.
- As of Jan 2024, Google Chrome is phasing in new restrictions around the use of third-party cookies. As a result, there are now some additional steps required to be able to access members-only data from within the extension; as detailed below:

Allowing third-party cookies

- Locrating uses cookies to know if you are logged in or not. Google Chrome is phasing in extra security checks around the use of third-party cookies; see <https://blog.google/products/chrome/privacy-sandbox-tracking-protection/>. We have updated this extension to be compatible with the new Google Chrome third party cookie rules.
- This update requires users to agree to the use of Locrating cookies; which are essential to the running of the extension. To approve Locrating cookies, click the yellow button as shown below:




- A message will popup asking you to confirm that portal.locrating.com can use cookies, click Allow and you will then be able to access members-only data. If you don't click Allow, Locrating won't know when you are signed in and you won't be able to access any members-only data.



- You may need refresh the page to see the map afterwards (press F5 to do this).
- Google Chrome will prompt you every 30 days, you should click Allow each time.

Removing the Locrating Property Portal Chrome extension

- Click the Extensions icon (jigsaw image) to the right of the search bar:



- Click the Remove button
